## **2017 SENATE BILL 710**

2017 Senate Bill 710 directs the Legislative Fiscal Bureau and Legislative Council staff to jointly prepare a report within 90 days after each biennial budget takes effect, and by the end of this calendar year for the current budget. The report must identify each program involving an aggregate amount of more than \$5 million in federal funds, any conditions attached to such funds, and any such condition that could be considered to be coercive, as defined in the bill. The bill also authorizes the Attorney General to bring an action to challenge such conditions, and requires the Governor to consult with governors in other states to develop a coordinated approach to coercive conditions.

## SENATE AMENDMENT 1

Senate Amendment 1 removes the provision requiring the Governor to consult with the governors of other states to develop a coordinated approach to coercive conditions.

## **BILL HISTORY**

Senator Stroebel offered Senate Amendment 1 on February 7, 2018. On February 14, 2018, the Senate Committee on Insurance, Financial Services, Constitution, and Federalism voted unanimously to recommend adoption of the amendment. On the same day, the committee voted to recommend passage of the bill, as amended, on a vote of Ayes, 3; Noes, 2.
