2017 SENATE BILL 211

April 20, 2017 - Introduced by Senators C. LARSON, JOHNSON, BEWLEY, SHILLING, L. TAYLOR, HANSEN, RINGHAND, CARPENTER, WIRCH and RISSER, cosponsored by Representatives BOWEN, GENRICH, CROWLEY, POPE, SINICKI, RIEMER, ANDERSON, VRUWINK, CONSIDINE, SPREITZER, SUBECK, OHNSTAD, BERCEAU, SARGENT, BILLINGS, SHANKLAND, ZAMARRIPA, WACHS, C. 1 **AN ACT** *to repeal* 115.882; and *to amend* 20.255 (2) (b) of the statutes; **relating**
2 **to:** increase funding for special education.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill increases state aid to school districts for special education and school age parents programs provided by the school district to no less than 33 percent of the school district's certified, eligible costs.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 **SECTION 1.** 20.255 (2) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:

3 **SECTION 2.** 115.882 of the statutes is repealed.

4 **SECTION 3. Effective date.**

5 (1) This act takes effect on the day after publication, or on the 2nd day after
6 publication of the 2017-19 biennial budget act, whichever is later.
