TO THE HONORABLE MEMBERS OF THE ASSEMBLY:

I am vetoing Assembly Bill 53 in its entirety.

This bill relates to pupil records. Under current law, directory data may be disclosed to any person if the public school notifies parents or guardians of the information designated as directory data, provides information on how to opt out of disclosures, and provides sufficient time to use the opt-out procedure. Under this bill, the name of a pupil's parents or guardians would be added to the list of categories that a public school must designate as directory data.

I am vetoing this bill in its entirety because I object to implementing a mandate that will negatively impact the privacy of parents of students in Wisconsin. I also object because the bill provides Wisconsin families with fewer privacy protections than the federal Family Education Rights Privacy Act, which does not include parent or guardian names in its definition of directory data. Wisconsin law should provide greater protections for privacy than federal law, not fewer.

2019 WISCONSIN ACT

AN ACT *to amend* 118.125 (1) (b) of the statutes; **relating to:** pupil records.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 118.125 (1) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:

118.125 (1) (b) "Directory data" means those pupil records which include the pupil's name, address, tele-

phone listing, date and place of birth, major field of study, participation in officially recognized activities and sports, weight and height of ~~members as a member of an athletic teams~~ team, dates of attendance, photographs, degrees and awards received, the name of the pupil's parents or guardians, and the name of the school most recently previously attended by the pupil.

* Section 991.11, WISCONSIN STATUTES: Effective date of acts. "Every act and every portion of an act enacted by the legislature over the governor's partial veto which does not expressly prescribe the time when it takes effect shall take effect on the day after its date of publication."
