Require DPI to develop K-12 American Indian studies model academic standards focused on the federally recognized American Indian tribes and bands located in Wisconsin. The standards shall address contemporary and historic tribal sovereignty, culture, and significant events, including information regarding trust lands, treaty rights, reservations, gaming compacts, the Indian Child Welfare Act, water rights, effigy mounds, and race-based mascots. The standard shall be developed in consultation with the Wisconsin Indian Education Association.
