**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1,
TO ASSEMBLY BILL 230**

February 20, 2020 - Offered by Representative SWEARINGEN.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 1, line 4: after “colleges” insert “, funding for PFAS research and
3 investigations, granting rule-making authority, and making an appropriation”.

4 **2.** Page 2, line 1: before that line insert:

7 fund, as a continuing appropriation, the amounts in the schedule for PFAS-related
8 activities by the freshwater collaborative and schools of public health under s. 36.25
9 (56) (a) 3.

10 **SECTION 1g.** 20.370 (4) (as) of the statutes is created to read:

11 20.370 (4) (as) *PFAS — drinking water sampling and investigations.* From the
12 environmental fund, as a continuing appropriation, the amounts in the schedule for
13 testing water samples for the presence of any perfluoroalkyl or polyfluoroalkyl
14 substance for which the department has received a recommendation from the
15 department of health services under s. 160.07 (3), in noncommunity water systems
16 and municipal public water supply systems, as defined by the department by rule,
17 that are in proximity to sites or facilities listed in the department’s online Bureau for
18 Remediation and Redevelopment Tracking System as containing perfluoroalkyl or
19 polyfluoroalkyl contamination or as having discharged perfluoroalkyl or
20 polyfluoroalkyl substances; for investigating emerging contaminants that are
21 perfluoroalkyl or polyfluoroalkyl substances in those areas; and for providing
22 temporary potable water or treatment systems in those areas when no responsible
23 party for contamination is available.”.
