1 **AN ACT ...; relating to:** harbor assistance grant for the city of Green Bay.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, the Department of Transportation administers a harbor assistance program. Under the program, an eligible applicant may be awarded a grant to partially reimburse the applicant for expenses incurred in making certain harbor improvements. This bill requires DOT to award a harbor assistance grant of not more than \$1,500,000 to the city of Green Bay for harbor improvements related to the relocation of coal piles.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

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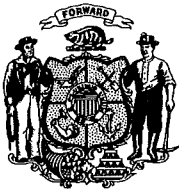
