Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill eliminates the requirement that the Department of Natural Resources issue a state trail pass and prohibits DNR from charging a person an admission fee for entering any state trail.

Under current law, DNR is required to issue an annual state trail pass that authorizes admission to a state trail for a fee of \$25. DNR also issues a daily state trail pass for a fee of \$5. DNR is authorized to waive or alter these fees for certain classes of persons or groups, certain areas, certain types of visitation or times of the year, admission to special scheduled events or programs, or on a per person basis.

Gary would like a bill introduced that eliminates trail passes for state parks and trails for all activities.

Currently, state statute allows DNR to collect fees for trail use. DNR's administrative rules exempts pedestrians, snowmobilers, and ATV users. This means that bikers, cross country skiers, and horse riders do need to be for trail fees before using them. Gary would like the bill to simply eliminate the state trail fee for all of those users as provided in <u>s. 27.01 (8)</u>, <u>Stats</u> (though I'm not sure if there are other statutes that would need to be changed as well). He does *not* want to eliminate the vehicle admission fee. If we could have that by early next week we would appreciate it. 
