Hi Mary,

We are looking at drafting an amendment for AB 353. I have sent below what we are looking for in an amendment. Please give me a call if you have any questions. Thanks!

Thanks again for sending this over yesterday. We appreciate that the camp association is agreeable with camps paying the yearly inspection fee, and making the reduced inspection frequency optional rather than mandatory. Shown next are two options for wording that we would also find acceptable. We propose eliminating the language "that is required for license renewal" because inspections aren't generally required for renewal of camp license. We also propose eliminating mention of the ACA accreditation so that non-ACA camps may achieve a reduced-frequency status, too. Below are a couple of options our staff wanted to send along for consideration:

- "For a recreational or educational camp....agent status under s. 97.615(2) may waive, for not more than 2 out of every 3 license years, any <u>routine</u> inspection for those license years. <u>Annual license fees and</u> all other applicable requirements shall apply to the camp."
- 2. "For a recreational or educational camp....agent status under s. 97.615(2) <u>may</u> waive, for <u>not more than</u> 2 out of every 3 license years, any <u>routine</u> inspection for those license years <u>if the camp has exhibited effective</u> <u>managerial control of public health hazards, as defined by the department in rule</u>. <u>Annual license fees and all other applicable requirements shall apply to the camp."</u>



At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

1. Page 2, line 1: delete the material beginning with "shall waive" and ending with "All" on line 3 and substitute "may waive, for not more than 2 out of every 3 license years, any routine inspection for those license years if the camp has exhibited effective managerial control of public health hazards, as defined by the department by rule. Annual license fees and all".
