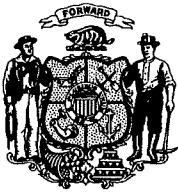

Grant Program for Anti-Choking devices in Schools

- Grant program to provide anti-choking devices to WI schools
- \$500,000
- 25 percent match (could come from outside donations)
- 1 grant per school district
- Any unused funds would be lapsed back to the general fund
- Limit of 3 devices per school
- Applicant will need to submit a training plan and protocols for the anti-choking device as part of the application to DHS.
- DHS must certify the anti-choking device

Konrad,

Rep. Tranel and Sen. Marklein would like to have a couple of tweaks made to the anti-chocking bill draft you did for us.

1. (Section 2, line 19-20) We need to clarify that all WI school can apply including: public school districts, independent charter, choice, and private schools. DPI said there is some standard legislative language that is typically used here. Only focusing on "each school district" might leave out some schools was the concern.
2. (Section 3, lines 1-3) We need to clarify that within a school district each school can only receive a grant for a max of 3 devices per school. Apparently, there are some state school districts that only technically have one building, but within it they have an elementary, middle, and high school. Given how spread out these schools could be and that they could have multiple gyms, cafeterias, ect, we want to make sure that it's clear that they could write a grant and apply for up to 3 devices for each of the schools. So, in this example a total of 9 devices.
