Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill appropriates from the general fund \$11,000,000 in the 2019–21 fiscal biennium as state aid for the technical college system.

For further information see the *state and local* fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Fiscal changes.

- (1) In the schedule under s. 20.005 (3) for the appropriation to the technical college system board under s. 20.292(1) (d), the dollar amount for fiscal year 2019–20 is decreased by \$500,000 and the dollar amount for fiscal year 2020–21 is increased by \$11,500,000 for the purpose for which the appropriation is made.
 - Section 2. Effective date.

1	(1) This act takes effect on the day after publication, or on the 2nd day after
2	publication of the 2019 biennial budget act, whichever is later.
