Hi Eric,

Our office recently had a meeting with officials from Washington County and stakeholders in the Wisconsin 9/11 Memorial, and a few changes to the current draft of LRB-3727 were proposed and agreed upon by all. The changes are as follows:

Section 1

CREATED

84.10*** Wisconsin 9/11 Memorial Highway

(1) The department shall designate and mark the following route as the Wisconsin 9/11 Memorial Highway as a living memorial for the lives lost on the September 11, 2001, terrorist attacks, for protective services personnel who responded to the attacks and for the Veterans who served in subsequent conflicts.

(a) In Dodge County, the I41 and STH 28 interchange proceeding east on STH 28. *(or county line?)*

(b) In Washington County, STH 28 east turning south on US 45 turning east on STH 28 and ending in the town of Farmington at STH 144.

(c) The department shall mark this route, by erecting and maintaining appropriate signs, to clearly identify to motorists the route as the "Wisconsin 9/11 Memorial Highway."

(2) Along the route within the village of Kewaskum, sits the Wisconsin 9/11 Memorial and Education Center which will serve to honor those who perished, and as a space of reflection for the State of Wisconsin.

(a) The department shall/(may) erect and maintain directional signs for the Wisconsin 9/11 Memorial along I-41, US 45 and STH 28 *(in Washington County or any county adjacent)*. *(cross-reference to 86.19 needed?)*

84.101 **Military memorial highways and bridges.** The department shall maintain all markers that designate any state trunk highway or bridge on the state trunk highway system as a memorial that is associated with the armed forces or any branch or unit of the armed forces, any specific soldier or soldiers, any armed forces award or honor, or any war or armed conflict, or that is otherwise military in nature, including the Wisconsin 9/11 Memorial Highway and, notwithstanding ss. 84.1028 (2), 84.1029 (2), 84.1031 (2), 84.1034 (2), 84.1036 (2), 84.1039 (2), and 84.1041 (2), the department shall bear the cost, in an amount not to exceed a total of \$2,000 per year on a statewide basis, of such maintenance and shall only perform maintenance under this section in amounts above that sum to the extent that the department has received local or private funding for such maintenance.

AMENDED

84.02(5)(d)1. Identification of each Veterans memorial highway or bridge, including the Wisconsin 9/11 Memorial Highway designated under this chapter.

Section 4

CREATED

84.02 (5) (d) 2. p. The Wisconsin 9/11 Memorial and Education Center in the village of Kewaskum in Washington County.

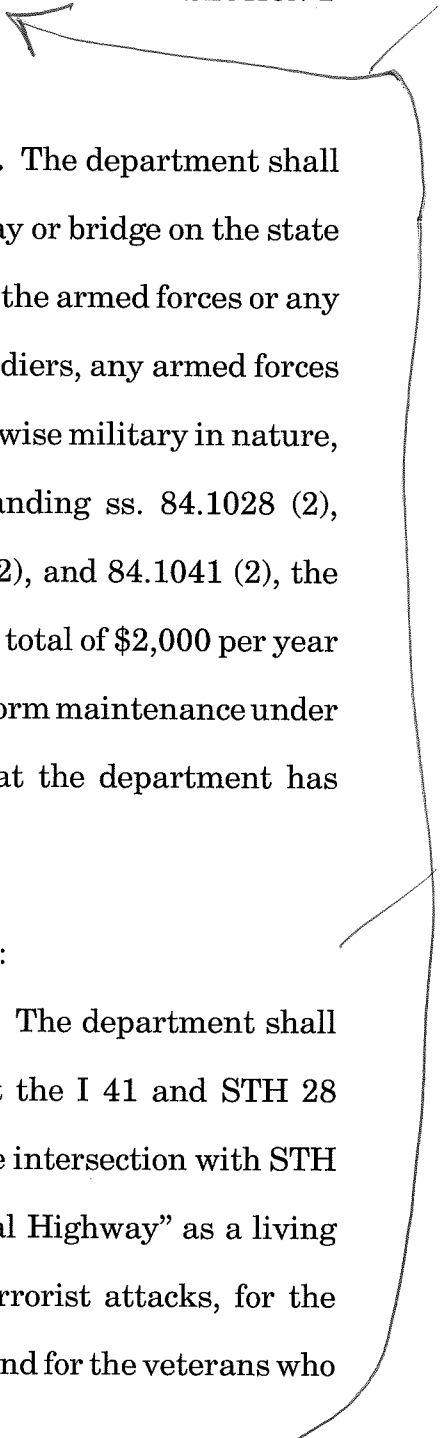
