1 AN ACT to create 20.855 (4) (bg) of the statutes; relating to: the University of  
2 Wisconsin Missing-in-Action Recovery and Identification Project and making

*Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau*

Under this bill, the University of Wisconsin Missing-in-Action Recovery and Identification Project (MIA Recovery Project) may request the Joint Committee on Finance to provide \$180,000 in each fiscal year of the 2019-21 fiscal biennium for missions to recover and identify Wisconsin veterans who are missing in action. JCF may approve the request, after considering any recommendation from the standing committee of each house of the legislature dealing with veterans matters (veterans committee), if the request includes a research prospectus and spending plan for the mission for which the funding is requested. If JCF approves the request, JCF must provide the requested amount of funding directed to the MIA Recovery Project Fund. At the conclusion of the mission for which funding was provided, the MIA Recovery Project must submit to JCF, and each veterans committee, a report on the mission's findings and an accounting of expenditures for the mission. The bill also creates a miscellaneous appropriation of general purpose revenue through which JCF provides the funding.
