- 1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:
- 2 **1.** Page 1, line 4: delete “The” and substitute “Except as provided in this
- 3 paragraph, the”.
- 4 **2.** Page 2, line 1: after “are” insert “operated on a highway and”.
- 5 **3.** Page 2, line 2: delete “and used primarily for transportation purposes”.
- 6 **4.** Page 2, line 5: delete lines 5 and 6 and substitute “vehicle is customarily
- 7 more often kept. An ordinance under this subsection may require that proof of
- 8 registration be displayed on or carried with the vehicle registered under this
- 9 subsection. An ordinance under this subsection may not require the registration of
- 10 an animal-drawn vehicle that is used solely for recreational purposes, including use
- 11 in a parade, or that is an implement of husbandry, as defined in s. 340.01 (24).”.
