

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill requires the Department of Transportation to develop and administer an airport sound mitigation grant program. Under the program, DOT must award grants for projects that mitigate the impact of airport sound on structures located near airports that include a military base or installation. DOT is required to give highest priority in awarding these grants to projects involving schools and child care centers and secondary priority to projects involving private residences. The bill provides \$250,000 in each year of the current fiscal biennium for the program.
