 - 2. Page 1, line 3: delete "Program" and substitute "Program, granting bonding authority, and making an appropriation".
 - **3.** Page 2, line 1: before that line insert:
- **"Section 1d.** 13.48 (27m) (ba) of the statutes is created to read: 7
- 13.48 (27m) (ba) The building commission may authorize up to a total of 8 \$30,957,000 in additional general fund supported borrowing for grants under par. 9 10 (b).
- **Section 1h.** 20.410 (3) (fn) of the statutes is created to read: 11
- 20.410 (3) (fn) Secured residential care centers for children and youth; 12 supplemental funding. A sum sufficient to reimburse s. 20.866 (1) (u) for the 13
