1 AN ACT to amend 104.045 (1) of the statutes; relating to: counting of tips for

tipped employees and granting rule-making authority.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill requires the Department of Workforce Development to promulgate rules allowing an employer to require tipped employees to use an electronic signature or other electronic means that uniquely identifies the employee when acknowledging the counting of tips toward fulfillment of the employer's obligation to pay the minimum wage.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. 104.045 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

104.045 (1) The counting of tips or similar gratuities toward fulfillment of the employer's obligation under this chapter s. 104.035 (3). The rules promulgated under this subsection shall allow an employer to require a tipped employee to use an electronic signature or other electronic means that uniquely identifies the employee
