This version of the draft eliminates the effective date provision. The effective date language was originally included in case the bill passed before the biennial budget. Since the 2019–21 biennial budget has now been passed, there is no longer any need for the provision, and the default effective date will apply such that, if passed and signed into law, the bill's provisions would take effect on the day after publication.
