~~The first attachment is how we're conceiving of a bill that would expand the state's public health authority. We'd like this as a standalone bill.~~

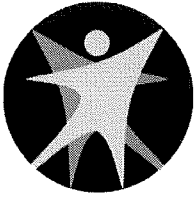
Second, we'd like a bill that would provide some additional resources to both the state and local entities. The purpose of this bill is twofold:

1. Fund a public health campaign by allocating additional funding to DHS to develop and carry out a public campaign aimed at prevention of initiation of tobacco & e-cigarette use.
2. Increase grant funding to local and regional organizations working on youth vaping/providing cessation services.

In both instances, the funding should be directed to our tobacco program. The Chapter 20 statutory citation for the tobacco program is 20.435(1)(fm)

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill provides additional funding to the Department of Health Services to develop and carry out a public health campaign aimed at the prevention of initiation of tobacco and electronic cigarette use. The bill also provides funding to DHS to distribute grants to local and regional organizations working on youth vaping and providing cessation services.
For further information see the *state* fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

4 SECTION 1. 255.15³ (3) (d) of the statutes is created to read:
5 255.15³ (3) (d) From the appropriation under s. 20.435¹ (1) (fm), the department
6 may develop and implement a public health campaign aimed at the prevention of

1 initiation of tobacco and electronic cigarette use and may award grants for local and
2 regional organizations working on youth vaping and providing cessation services.

****NOTE: Please note that while the appropriation language itself for s. 20.435 (1) (fm) is broad enough to incorporate any programs described under s. 255.15 (3), including vaping-related programs, as you noted, the appropriation in s. 20.435 (1) (fm) is titled "Tobacco use control" and currently covers tobacco use-related grants. I have not retitled the appropriation for purposes of this draft, but please let me know if you would like to modify the title to incorporate reference to the new programs relating to vaping.

3 **SECTION 2.** 255.15 (4) of the statutes is amended to read:

4 255.15 (4) REPORTS. Not later than April 15, 2002 2021, and annually
5 thereafter, the department shall submit to the governor and to the chief clerk of each
6 house of the legislature for distribution under s. 13.172 (2) a report that evaluates
7 the success of the ~~grant program~~ programs under sub. (3). The report shall specify
8 the number of grants awarded during the immediately preceding fiscal year and the
9 purpose for which each grant was made. The report shall also specify donations and
10 grants accepted by the department under sub. (5).

****NOTE: Because the initial draft incorporates a new separate grant program (as well as a public health campaign), I broadened the language of this reporting provision to incorporate both the new grant program and the public health campaign. Please let me know if this is consistent with your intent.

11 **SECTION 3. Fiscal changes.**

12 (1) PUBLIC HEALTH CAMPAIGN AND GRANTS FOR VAPING PREVENTION AND CESSATION.
13 In the schedule under s. 20.005 (3) for the appropriation to the department of health
14 services under s. 20.435 (1) (fm), the dollar amount for fiscal year 2019-20 is
15 increased by \$100 to fund a public health campaign aimed at prevention of initiation
16 of tobacco and electronic cigarette use and grants for local and regional organizations
17 working on youth vaping and providing cessation services. In the schedule under s.
18 20.005 (3) for the appropriation to the department of health services under s. 20.435
19 (1) (fm), the dollar amount for fiscal year 2020-21 is increased by \$100 to fund a

- 1 public health campaign aimed at prevention of initiation of tobacco and electronic
- 2 cigarette use and grants for local and regional organizations working on youth
- 3 vaping and providing cessation services.

****NOTE: In this initial draft, I have included an annual dollar amount of \$100 only as a placeholder until the appropriate amounts are determined. As soon you have determined the amounts you would like included, I will incorporate those into a subsequent version.
