Thanks for speaking with me last week. As we discussed, DHS is interested in developing a few pieces of legislation that would the state and local communities to better respond to public health matters; and in this case, the rise of ecigarette use amongst youth.

The first attachment is how we're conceiving of a bill that would expand the state's public health authority. We'd like this as a standalone bill.

/Second, we'd like a bill that would provide some additional resources to both the state and local entities. The purpose of this bill is twofold:

- 1. Fund a public health campaign by allocating additional funding to DHS to develop and carry out a public campaign aimed at prevention of initiation of tobacco & e-cigarette use.
- 2. Increase grant funding to local and regional organizations working on youth vaping/providing cessation services. In both instances, the funding should be directed to our tobacco program. The Chapter 20 statutory citation for the tobacco program is 20.435(1)(fm)


