<u>Statement of Motion Intent:</u> Provide a one-time state investment of \$3 million in veteran housing that serves several counties and veteran needs through assisted living stage. The investment would be disbursed when the private fundraising threshold of \$12 million is reached.

Agency: Dept. of Veterans Affairs

Summary:

Veterans Village of Wisconsin, Inc. and the Outagamie County Housing Authority are working to develop the Glenpark Apartments site in Grand Chute for use as a local Veterans Village. This would provide veterans and their families with the resources they deserve, with housing, healthcare and community concentrated in one location.

The intent is to build a national model of a government and private partnership providing specialized care that veterans require.

The Veterans Village and Veterans Honor Home would be close to the Fox Valley Technical Colleges and the John H. Bradley VA Clinic, and serve the nearly 14,000 veterans living in Outagamie County, and more than 50,000 veterans living in the surrounding counties.




