1 AN ACT ^{generate} _{catalog} relating to: appointing inspectors for the canvassing of absentee
2 ballots.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Current law allows a municipality to appoint additional election inspectors for the canvassing of absentee ballots by the municipal board of absentee ballot canvassers. Under current law, an inspector so appointed must be a qualified elector of the municipality. This bill provides that if the municipality cannot identify a sufficient number of qualified electors of the municipality to serve as inspectors, the municipality may appoint qualified electors of the county in which the municipality is located to serve as inspectors.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 SECTION 1. 7.52 (1) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:
4 7.52 (1) (b) A municipality that adopts the canvassing procedure under this
5 section may appoint additional inspectors under s. 7.30 (2) (a) to assist the absentee
6 ballot board of canvassers in canvassing absentee ballots under this section. In such

SECTION 1

1 case, an odd number of inspectors shall be appointed, and at no time may there be
2 less than 3 inspectors who serve. Except as authorized in s. 7.30 (4) (c), all inspectors
3 shall be affiliated with one of the 2 recognized political parties receiving the largest
4 numbers of votes for president, or for governor in nonpresidential general election
5 years, in the municipality. The party whose candidate received the largest number
6 of votes in the municipality is entitled to one more inspector than the party whose
7 candidate received the next largest number of votes in the municipality. Each
8 inspector so appointed shall be a qualified elector of the municipality, except that if
9 the municipality cannot identify a sufficient number of qualified electors of the
10 municipality to serve as inspectors, the municipality may appoint qualified electors
11 of the county in which the municipality is located to serve as inspectors. The
12 inspectors who are appointed under this paragraph shall serve under the direction
13 and supervision of the board of absentee ballot canvassers.
