Authorize electronic certification of county board of canvass statements (June 20, 2017, memo, item 34 )

**Instructions:**

§ 7.60(5)(a). This provision requires county clerks to deliver or transmit to the Commission a certified copy of each county board of canvass statement. In current practice, county clerks use the Commission's Canvass Reporting System (CRS) to generate those statements using their secure login credentials, and then mail a signed copy of that report to the Commission. The Legislature could modernize this provision by adding the language in the manner prescribed by the commission after the county clerk shall deliver or transmit, or consider replacing the word certified with electronically signed. In 2014, the Legislature made a similar change, allowing political committees to sign their campaign

1 AN ACT ...; relating to: transmission of certified statements of county boards of  
2 canvassers concerning election canvasses.

***Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau***

Under current law, each county clerk is required to deliver or transmit to the Wisconsin Elections Commission a certified copy of each statement of a county board of canvassers regarding an election within certain specified time periods after primaries and all other elections. This bill specifies that the certified copies must be delivered or transmitted to the commission in a manner prescribed by the commission.

***The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:***

3 SECTION 1. 7.60 (5) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:  
4 7.60 (5) (a) Immediately following the canvass, the county clerk shall deliver  
5 or transmit to the elections commission in a manner prescribed by the commission  
6 a certified copy of each statement of the county board of canvassers for president and

1 vice president, state officials, senators and representatives in congress, state  
2 legislators, justice, court of appeals judge, circuit judge, district attorney, and  
3 metropolitan sewerage commissioners, if the commissioners are elected under s.  
4 200.09 (11) (am). The statement shall record the returns for each office or  
5 referendum by ward, unless combined returns are authorized under s. 5.15 (6) (b) in  
6 which case the statement shall record the returns for each group of combined wards.  
7 Following primaries the county clerk shall enclose on forms prescribed by the  
8 elections commission the names, party or principle designation, if any, and number  
9 of votes received by each candidate recorded in the same manner. The county clerk  
10 shall deliver or transmit the certified statement to the elections commission no later  
11 than 9 days after each primary except the partisan primary, no later than 10 days  
12 after the partisan primary and any other election except the general election, and no  
13 later than 14 days after the general election. The board of canvassers shall deliver  
14 or transmit a certified copy of each statement for any technical college district  
15 referendum to the secretary of the technical college district board.
