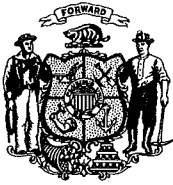

1 AN ACT *to create* 20.255 (2) (bp) and 118.50 (5m) of the statutes; **relating to:** a
2 whole grade sharing categorical aid for school boards and making an
3 appropriation.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill creates a categorical aid for school boards that enter into a whole grade sharing agreement and adopt a resolution to consider school district consolidation. Under the bill, the Department of Public Instruction pays an eligible school board an amount equal to \$150 per pupil enrolled in a grade included in the whole grade sharing agreement. A school board may not receive this aid for more than five school years.

Under current law, two or more school boards may enter into a whole grade sharing agreement, under which all or a substantial portion of the pupils enrolled in a specified grade in the participating school districts attend the specified grade in one of the participating school districts.

17 whole grade sharing agreement.**18 (c) 1. If the appropriation under s. 20.255 (2) (bp) is insufficient to pay the full**
19 amount under this subsection, the department shall prorate the payments among
20 the eligible school boards.**21 2. The department may not make payments to a school board under par. (b) for**
22 more than 5 school years of a whole grade sharing agreement.**23 SECTION 4. Effective date.**
