#### The law passed in Texas

Section 3. Subchapter A, Chapter 38, Education Code, is amended by adding Section 38.0042 to read as follows:

Sec.38.0042. POSTING CHILD ABUSE HOTLINE TELEPHONE NUMBER. (a) Each public school and openenrollment charter school shall post in a clearly visible location in a public area of the school that is readily accessible to students a sign in English and in Spanish that contains the toll-free telephone number operated by the Department of Family and Protective Services to receive reports of child abuse or neglect.

(b) The commissioner may adopt rules relating to the size and location of the sign required by Subsection (a).

The statute authorized the commissioner to adopt rules relating to the rules relating to the size and location of the sign. Here's the relevant portion of the rule.


- 61.1051. Reporting Child Abuse Neglect.
- (e) Using a format and language that is clear, simple, and understandable to students, each public school and open-enrollment charter school shall post, in English and Spanish:
- (1) The current too-free Texas Department of Family and Protective Service Abuse Hotline telephone number:
- (2) Instructions to call 911 for emergencies: and
- (3) directions for accessing the Texas Department of Family Protective Services Website (<a href="https://www.txabusehotline.org">www.txabusehotline.org</a>) for more information on reporting abuse, neglect, and exploitation.
- (f)School districts and open-enrollment charter schools shall post the information specified in subsection (e) of this section at each school campus in at least one high-traffic, highly and clearly visible public area that is readily accessible to and widely used by students. The information must be on a poster (11x17 inches or larger) in large print and placed at eye level to the student for easy viewing. Additionally, the current toll-free Texas Department of Family and Protective Services Abuse Hotline telephone number should be in bold print.
