1 **Resolved by the senate, the assembly concurring, That:**

2 **SECTION 1. 2017-2018 session schedule.** (1) BIENNIAL SESSION PERIOD. The
3 legislature declares that the biennial session period of the 2017 Wisconsin
4 legislature began on Tuesday, January 3, 2017, and that the biennial session period
5 ends at noon on Monday, January 7, 2019.

6 (2) BUDGET DEADLINE EXTENDED. The deadline of Tuesday, January 24, 2017, set
7 by section 16.45 of the statutes for introduction of the executive budget bill or bills,
8 submittal of the state budget report, and delivery of the governor's budget message,
9 is extended to Wednesday, February 8, 2017.

10 (3) SCHEDULED FLOORPERIODS AND COMMITTEE WORK PERIODS. (a) *Unreserved*
11 *days.* Unless reserved under this subsection as a day to conduct an organizational
12 meeting or to be part of a scheduled floorperiod of the legislature, every day of the
13 biennial session period is designated as a day for committee activity and is available
14 to extend a scheduled floorperiod, convene an extraordinary session, or take senate
15 action on appointments as permitted by joint rule 81.

16 (b) *Inauguration.* Pursuant to section 13.02 (1) of the statutes, the
17 inauguration of the members of the 2017 legislature, and the organizing for business
18 of the 2 houses, commences at 2 p.m. on Tuesday, January 3, 2017.

19 (c) *Floorperiod.* A floorperiod commences on Tuesday, January 10, 2017, at 10
20 a.m., and ends on January 10, 2017.

1 (d) *Floorperiod.* A floorperiod commences on Tuesday, January 17, 2017, at 10
2 a.m., and, unless adjourned earlier, ends on Thursday, January 19, 2017.

3 (e) *Floorperiod.* A floorperiod commences on Tuesday, February 7, 2017, at 10
4 a.m., and ends on Thursday, February 9, 2017.

9 (h) *Bills to governor.* No later than Thursday, April 20, 2017, at 4:30 p.m., the
10 chief clerk of each house shall submit to the governor for executive action thereon all
11 enrolled bills originating in the chief clerk's house and having been passed by both
12 houses, in regular, extraordinary, or special session, on or before Thursday, April 6,
13 2017.

14 (i) *Floorperiod.* A floorperiod commences on Tuesday, May 2, 2017, at 10 a.m.,
15 and, unless adjourned earlier, ends on Thursday, May 11, 2017.

16 (j) *Floorperiod.* A floorperiod commences on Tuesday, June 6, 2017, at 10 a.m.,
17 and, unless adjourned earlier, ends on Friday, June 30, 2017, but this floorperiod may
18 not be adjourned until the general fund executive budget bill has been passed by both
19 houses.

20 (k) *Nonbudget bills to governor.* No later than Thursday, August 3, 2017, at 4:30
21 p.m., the chief clerk of each house shall submit to the governor for executive action
22 thereon all enrolled bills, except the general fund executive budget bill, originating
23 in the chief clerk's house and having been passed by both houses, in regular,
24 extraordinary, or special session, on or before Friday, July 28, 2017.

1 (L) *Budget bill to governor.* No later than the later of Thursday, August 3, 2017,
2 at 4:30 p.m., or 4:30 p.m. on the 4th Thursday after the general fund executive budget
3 bill is passed by both houses in identical form, the chief clerk of each house shall
4 submit to the governor for executive action thereon any enrolled general fund
5 executive budget bill originating in the chief clerk's house and having been passed
6 by both houses, in regular, extraordinary, or special session.

5 22, 2018.

16 2018.

17 (w) *Veto review floorperiod.* A floorperiod, limited to matters allowed under
18 joint rule 82 (1m), commences on Tuesday, May 8, 2018, at 10 a.m., and, unless
19 adjourned earlier, ends on Wednesday, May 9, 2018.

20 (x) *Bills to governor.* No later than Wednesday, May 23, 2018, at 4:30 p.m., the
21 chief clerk of each house shall submit to the governor for executive action thereon all
22 enrolled bills originating in the chief clerk's house and having been passed by both
23 houses, in regular, extraordinary, or special session, on or before Wednesday, May 9,

7 constitute final adjournment of the special or extraordinary session.

8 (b) *Bills to governor*. No later than 4:30 p.m. on the first Thursday occurring
9 2 full weeks after the day a bill is passed by both houses in identical form after May
10 9, 2018, ^{pe 13 pe 20} in special or extraordinary session, the chief clerk of the house in which it
11 originated shall submit it to the governor for executive action thereon.

12 (c) *Veto review*. A special or extraordinary session shall reconvene upon a call
13 of a majority of the members of the joint committee on legislative organization solely
14 for the consideration of executive vetoes or partial vetoes if an enrolled bill passed
15 by both houses during the special or extraordinary session was vetoed or partially
16 vetoed.

17 (6) END OF TERM. The biennial term of the 2017 legislature ends on Monday,
18 January 7, 2019. Pursuant to section 13.02 (1) of the statutes, the inauguration of
19 the members of the 2019 legislature will be on Monday, January 7, 2019. ^{pe 19}
