- 11 Whereas, the Titan's Jack Flynn was named the Most Outstanding Player at
12 the Final Four, ^{and led} paced five Titan starters in double figures with a career-high 33 ✓

1 Whereas, Connor Duax added 16 points for the Titans, who also received 14
 2 apiece from Adam Fravert and Brett Wittchow, and 10 from Ben Boots. Fravert, who
 3 joined Flynn on the five-member All-Tournament Team, led all players with 12
 4 rebounds for his 15th career double-double; and

5 Whereas, Coach Matt Lewis, in his first year as head coach, became the first
 6 from UW-Oshkosh to receive the National Association of Basketball Coaches
 7 (NABC) Central Region Men's Coach of the Year; and

8 Whereas, Senior Guard Ben Boots was named to the D3Hoops.com
 9 All-American First Team and Junior Center Jack Flynn was named to the Fourth
 10 Team; and

11 Whereas, the UW-Oshkosh men's team finished a historic season reaching
 12 their second straight NCAA Final Four, which included a program-record 21 game
 13 winning streak, the school's first outright Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic
 14 Conference title since 1978, and an overall record of 29-3; now, therefore, be it

15 *Resolved by the senate, the assembly concurring, That* the members of the
 16 Wisconsin Legislature congratulate the University of Wisconsin-Oshkosh men's
 17 basketball team on their outstanding achievement and accomplishments.

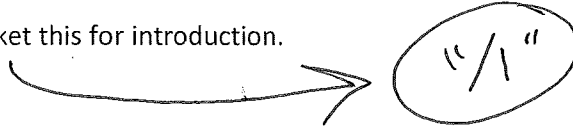
