April 18, 2019 – Introduced by Representatives Hebl, Oldenburg, Crowley, Doyle, Hesselbein, Kulp, Milroy, Petryk, Pope, Sargent, Sinicki, Spreitzer, Stubbs, C. Taylor, Tusler and Vruwink, cosponsored by Senators Miller, Shilling, Bewley, Cowles, Hansen, Olsen, Ringhand, Risser and Wirch. Referred to Committee on Rules.

1 Relating to: proclaiming May 17, 18, and 19, 2019, Syttende Mai Weekend.  $\mathbf{2}$ Whereas, Norway, which means "Northern Way," is the sixth-largest country 3 in Europe, covering 148,715 square miles, and has a population of more than 5 4 million people; and 5 Whereas, Norwegian immigrants have made countless contributions to the cultures of Wisconsin and other regions of the United States; and 6 7 Whereas, one out of every twelve Wisconsinites claims Norwegian ancestry; 8 and 9 Whereas, "Syttende Mai," Norwegian for "May 17," celebrates the anniversary 10 of the 1814 signing of the Norwegian Constitution that declared Norway's 11 independence from Denmark; and 12 Whereas, the Norwegian Constitution is the third-oldest in the world, being 13 predated only by the constitutions of the United States and France; and

9	Whereas, thousands of Wisconsin residents of Norwegian heritage will

11	Resolved by the assembly, the senate concurring, That the Wisconsin
12	Legislature proclaims the weekend of May 17, 18, and 19, 2019, Syttende Mai
13	Weekend in the state of Wisconsin, and declares that all residents of this state are
14	honorary Norwegians for that weekend and are urged to observe the Syttende Mai
