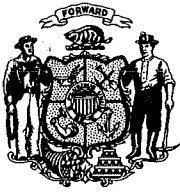

1 **Relating to:** honoring the life and public service of Senator John Maurer.

2 Whereas, on March 31, 2019, John Joseph Maurer passed away at the age of  
3 96; and

4 Whereas, Maurer served in the Wisconsin State Senate from 1975 to 1984,  
5 representing the people of the 22nd Senate District; and

6 Whereas, Maurer was born in Kenosha, Wisconsin, in 1922 to John and Anna  
7 (Schuenemann) Maurer; and

8 Whereas, during World War II, Maurer served in the Army Air Corps, and in  
9 1945 ~~Maurer went on to command~~ <sup>ed</sup> a B24 "Liberator" in the 15th Air Force Division;  
10 and

11 Whereas, after Maurer completed his military service he went on to study at  
12 Marquette University before becoming a pilot with United Airlines, flying over  
13 25,000 hours during his tenure; and

1           Whereas, from 1969 to 1975, Maurer served as the Town Chairman of Pleasant  
2   Prairie; and

3           Whereas, Maurer's dedication to public service continued in April of 1975 when  
4   he was elected in a special election to Wisconsin's 22nd Senate District and served  
5   four more terms in the legislature, and

6           Whereas, in 1985 Maurer was appointed by Governor Tony Earl to serve as the  
7   Secretary of the Department of Veterans Affairs; and

8           Whereas, Maurer served as Secretary until 1992, during which time he was  
9   instrumental in the creation of the Wisconsin Veterans Museum which is now located  
10   on the Capitol Square; and

11          Whereas, the Union Grove Veterans Home went on to dedicate Maurer Hall  
12   after his namesake; and *in his honor*

13          Whereas, Maurer is survived by his wife, Arlene; daughter, Lisa Patrick Walls;  
14   son, Thomas Maurer; and *his* grandchildren, Noah, John, and Levi; and

15          Whereas, Maurer is remembered by his wonderful humor, and passion for golf;  
16   and *for*

17          Whereas, Maurer will be greatly missed by his family and community in  
18   Kenosha to which he dedicated so much of his life; now, therefore, be it

19          *Resolved by the senate, the assembly concurring, That* the members of the  
20   Wisconsin Legislature salute the life and public service of John Joseph Maurer and  
21   mourn his passing; and, be it further

22          *Resolved, That* the senate chief clerk shall provide a copy of this joint  
23   resolution to the family of John Joseph Maurer.
