

confidence of the American people while adding to the proud legacy of the Army; and

soldiers serving in the Army and their legacy of brave service to our state and nation
as a whole; now, therefore, be it
Resolved by the assembly, the senate concurring, That the Wisconsin
Legislature declares the week of June 9 to 16, 2019, as Army Week to recognize the
