2 Whereas, the Milwaukee Bucks ended their 2018-19 regular season with a
3 record of 60-22, finishing with the best record in the league for the second time in
4 the team's history and their most wins since the 1980-81 season; and

5 Whereas, the Milwaukee Bucks were the Central Division Champions and
6 finished first in the NBA Eastern Conference for the first time since the 2000-01
7 season; and

8 Whereas, the Milwaukee Bucks advanced to the Eastern Conference Finals for
9 the first time since the 2000-01 season and were two wins away from making the
10 NBA Finals; and

11 Whereas, the Milwaukee Bucks led the NBA in points per game and rebounds
12 per game; and

13 Whereas, Giannis Antetokounmpo was selected for the All NBA First Team and
14 led the Milwaukee Bucks in points, assists, and rebounds per game; and
