

3	Whereas, Transgender Day of Remembrance, which occurs annually on				
4	November 20, is a day to memorialize those who have been murdered as a result of				
5	transphobia and to bring attention to the continued violence endured by the				
6	transgender community; and				
7	Whereas, Transgender Day of Remembrance was founded in 1999 by				
8	Gwendolyn Ann Smith, a transgender woman, to memorialize the murder of				
9	transgender woman Rita Hester in Allston, Massachusetts; and				
10	Whereas, since its inception, Transgender Day of Remembrance has been held				
11	annually on November 20, and it has slowly evolved from the web-based project				
12	annually on November 20, and it has slowly evolved from the web-based project started by Smith into an international day of action. Transgender Day of				
13	Remembrance has been observed in over 185 cities throughout more than 20
