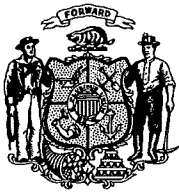

**PRIMARY AND SECONDARY EDUCATION**

This bill clarifies that DPI may award a robotics league participation grant to an eligible team to participate in more than one robotics competition.

---

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

2 **SECTION 1.** 115.45 (title) of the statutes is amended to read:

3 **115.45 (title) Robotics league participation grants pilot program.**

4 **SECTION 2.** 115.45 (2) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:

5 115.45 (2) (a) Annually, the department shall notify school boards, operators  
6 of charter schools under s. 118.40 (2r) and (2x), governing bodies of private schools,  
7 and administrators of home-based private educational programs that applications

1 for grants ~~under this section~~ to participate in one or more robotics competitions will  
2 be accepted from eligible teams through a date set forth in the notice. As a condition  
3 of receiving a grant under this section, an applicant eligible team shall demonstrate  
4 to the satisfaction of the department that the applicant eligible team will provide  
5 matching funds in an amount equal to the amount awarded under this section.

6 **SECTION 3.** 115.45 (2) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:

7 115.45 (2) (b) From the appropriation under s. 20.255 (2) (dr), the department  
8 shall award ~~a grant of up to \$5,000~~ grants to eligible teams selected from the  
9 applicants under par. (a). Grant funds awarded under this section may be applied  
10 only towards allowable expenses. The department may not award more than \$5,000  
11 to an eligible team in a school year.
