6 (a) Fees required to enroll in a driver education course.

7 (b) Fees required to obtain an operator's license under ch. 343.

8 (c) The cost of motor vehicle liability insurance for the motor vehicle owned or
9 used by the individual while participating in the program and after obtaining an
10 operator's license, including any increase in the cost of motor vehicle liability
11 insurance on a motor vehicle owned by an out-of-home care provider and used by
12 the individual.

- Please also add "...for the purposes under s. 48.526 (2) (c) only for **the reimbursement of costs associated with juveniles who were alleged to have violated a state or federal criminal law or any civil law or municipal ordinance at age 17 or who were adjudicated delinquent at age 17, or for counties starting secured or joint secured residential care centers.**"
- In addition, please add a section that changes the years listed in 48.526 (7) and (8) so that they apply to the 2019-21 biennium.
