1 **AN ACT ...; relating to:** the budget.

EDUCATION

PRIMARY AND SECONDARY EDUCATION

This bill provides that the amount of per pupil aid in the 2018-19 school year, which is \$654 per pupil, continues at that level for future school years. Under current law, the amount of per pupil aid decreases to \$630 per pupil in the 2019-20 school year and in each school year thereafter.

For further information see the *state and local* fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

2 **SECTION 1.** 115.437 (2) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:

3 115.437 (2) (a) Except as provided in par. (b), annually on the 4th Monday of
4 March, the department shall pay to each school district an amount equal to the
5 average of the number of pupils enrolled in the school district in the current and 2

1 preceding school years multiplied by \$75 in the 2013-14 school year, by \$150 in the
2 2014-15 and 2015-16 school years, by \$250 in the 2016-17 school year, by \$450 in
3 the 2017-18 school year, and by \$654 in the 2018-19 school year, and by \$630 in each
4 school year thereafter. The department shall make the payments from the
5 appropriation under s. 20.255 (2) (aq).
