**SECTION 9134. Nonstatutory provisions; Public Instruction.**

(1) AFTER-SCHOOL PROGRAM GRANTS; EMERGENCY RULES. The department of public instruction may promulgate emergency rules under s. 227.24 to implement and administer s. 115.449. Notwithstanding s. 227.24 (1) (c) and (2), emergency rules promulgated under this subsection remain in effect until July 1, 2020, or the date on which permanent rules take effect, whichever is sooner. Notwithstanding s. 227.24 (1) (a) and (3), the department is not required to provide evidence that promulgating a rule under this subsection as an emergency rule is necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, or welfare and is not required to provide a finding of emergency for a rule promulgated under this subsection.
