Under current law, Wisconsin Shares is a part of the Wisconsin Works (W-2) program, which DCF administers and which provides work experience and benefits for low-income custodial parents who are at least 18 years old. Under current law, an individual who is the parent of a child under the age of 13 or, if the child is disabled, under the age of 19 who needs child care services to participate in various education or work activities, and who satisfies other eligibility criteria, may receive a child care subsidy for child care services under Wisconsin Shares.

DCF determines the maximum reimbursement rates for licensed child care services that are provided under Wisconsin Shares. DCF also determines the maximum reimbursement rates for services provided by certified family child care providers, but may set the rate for Level Ocertified family child care providers at no more than 75 percent of the licensed child care rate and for Level II certified family child care providers at no more than 50 percent of the licensed child care rate. Under this bill, these limits on the maximum rate for certified family child care providers are increased to 100 percent of the licensed child care rate.
