

This bill increases the rates that are paid to a foster parent or a kinship care relative (a relative other than a parent) who is providing care and maintenance for a child.

This bill increases the monthly basic maintenance rates that are paid by the state or a county to a foster parent for the care and maintenance of a child in a foster home certified to provide level one care by 2 percent beginning on January 1, 2020, and for a child in any foster home by 2 percent beginning on January 1, 2021. Beginning on January 1, 2020, the monthly rates are increased from \$244 to \$249 for a child of any age in a foster home certified to provide level one care.
