Intent:

The intent of this draft is to expand funding for runaway and homeless youth services by \$250,000 in each fiscal year. To do this, please consolidate s. 49.1385 into s. 48.481 (3), both of which provide expenditure authority for these services, and expand funding by an additional \$250,000. This would eliminate s. 49.1385 and move related expenditure authority to s. 48.481 (3), for a new total of 'not more than \$400,000 in each fiscal year.' If necessary, please clarify that 48.481 (3) would also apply to 'homeless and runaway youth' in addition to the current language that states 'runaway children.'
