Intent:

Create a new appropriation containing \$66,700 in FY20, and language requiring MCW to convene a statewide stakeholder group to plan and develop a concept paper, business plan and pro-forma for a Comprehensive Mental Health Consultation Program. MCW currently oversees the Wisconsin Child Psychiatry Consultation Program (CPCP) and has been building a perinatal psychiatry consultation program called the Periscope Project. Both programs provide: (1) physicians access to mental health consultation; (2) long-term education to providers on mental health prevention and treatment; and (3) referral support to identify additional mental health resources that may be available in the community. The current programs target child psychiatry and perinatal psychiatry. The new program would add general psychiatry, geriatric psychiatry and addiction medicine/psychiatry to the existing perinatal psychiatry program and the CPCP.

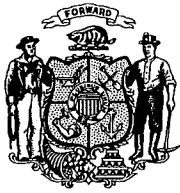
