This bill eliminates the requirement that individual income tax rates for the taxable year ending on December 31, 2019, be decreased in proportion to the increase in sales and use tax collections from October 1, 2018, to September 30, 2019, due to the expansion of the state's authority to collect sales and use taxes from out-of-state retailers, pursuant to the U.S. Supreme Court decision, South Dakota v. Wayfair, Inc., 585 U.S. (2018).

73.03 (71) (b) After the department makes the determination under par. (a),

order to decrease individual income tax revenue by the amount determined under
par. (a). For purposes of this paragraph, the tax rate reductions shall be calculated
in proportion to the share of gross tax attributable to each of the <u>lowest</u> tax brackets
under s. 71.06 in effect during the most recently completed taxable year.

Wayfair, Inc.*, 585 U.S. ___ (2018). The bill uses the increase in sales and use tax revenue to decrease the rate of the lowest tax bracket rather than the rate of all tax brackets.
