LOCAL GOVERNMENT MAY IMPOSE

This bill changes the allowable percentage increase of the property tax levy that may be imposed by a city, village, town, or county. Generally under current law, local levy limits are applied to the property tax levies that are imposed in December of each year. Current law prohibits any political subdivision from increasing its levy by a percentage that exceeds its valuation factor, which is defined as the greater of either 0 percent or the percentage change in the political subdivision's equalized value due to new construction, less improvements removed (net new construction). Under the bill, the valuation factor is defined as the greater of either 2 percent or the percentage change in net new construction.
