1 **AN ACT ...; relating to:** the budget.

EDUCATION

HIGHER EDUCATION

Under this bill, with certain exceptions, a technical college district board's revenue (defined as the sum of its tax levy for operations and the amount of aid it receives for property tax relief and tax-exempt personal property) in a school year may not exceed its revenue in the previous school year increased by 2 percent, or the district's valuation factor, whichever is greater. A district's valuation factor is the percentage change in the district's equalized value due to new construction, less improvements removed. Current law limits the increase to a district's valuation factor.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

2 **SECTION 1.** 38.16 (3) (be) of the statutes is amended to read:

3 38.16 (3) (be) Notwithstanding sub. (1), no district board may increase its
4 revenue in the 2014-15 school year or in any school year thereafter by a percentage

1 that exceeds 2 percent, or the district's valuation factor, whichever is greater, except
2 as provided in pars. (bg) and (br).
