1. Payment Indexing: parental choice programs, the Special Needs Scholarship Program, independent charter schools, full-time open enrollment program, and whole grade sharing agreements

Under current law, the per pupil payment amounts under the the Milwaukee Parental Choice Program, the Racine Parental Choice Program, the statewide parental choice program, and the Special Needs Scholarship Program, the per pupil payment amount to independent charter schools, the transfer amounts under the full-time open enrollment program, and the required transfer amount for a child with a disability in a whole grade sharing agreement (collectively "per pupil payments") are adjusted annually. The annual adjustment for per pupil payments is an amount equal to the sum of any per member revenue limit increase that applies to school districts in that school year and any per member increase in categorical aids between the current school year and the previous school year. Under the bill, beginning in the 2019–20 school year, the annual adjustment for per pupil payments is the sum of the per member revenue limit increase that applies to school districts in that school year, if any, and the increase, if any, in the per member amount of per pupil aid paid to school districts between the previous school year and the current school year.
