Hi Mary Alice,

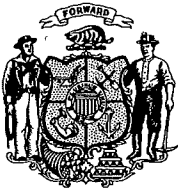
Could you tweak LRB-1805/P1 (pertaining to the ETF Pharmacy Cost Study committee) to say something to this effect:

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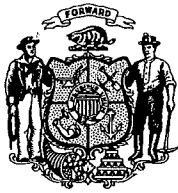
