Hi Amanda,

I am the drafter of the request below and need some clarification to finish the draft.

Under current law, there is a center for environmental education at UW-Stevens Point, which is funded from the UW general program operations appropriation (20.285 (1) (a)). The functions of the program are described in some detail in s. 36.25 (29m), but do not include anything related to grants.

Also under current law, the Board of Regents must provide \$300,000 each year from a specified appropriation to UW-Stevens Point for environmental programs. See s. 36.49 (3).

Is your intent to:

- 1. Fund the program under s. 36.25 (29m) from a separate appropriation with \$250,000 each year?
- 2. Require the UWSP environmental education program under s. 36.25 (29m) to make grants and, if so, to whom?
- 3. Add another \$250,000 to the \$300,000 allocated under s. 36.49 (3) for UWSP environmental programs, or replace part of the funding with funding from a different source?
- 4. Other.

This bill requires UW-Stevens Point to award grants, funded from the conservation fund, to nonprofit corporations and public agencies for the development, dissemination, and presentation of environmental education programs. No more than one-third of the total amount of grants awarded each year may be awarded to state agencies.

- (b) In consultation with the chancellor and faculty of the University of Wisconsin-Stevens Point, the board shall promulgate rules establishing the criteria and procedures for the awarding of grants under sub. (2). The University of Wisconsin-Stevens Point shall use the priorities established under par.
