Under s. 49.45 and 49.46, add a benefit that provides Medicaid reimbursement for non-medical services connected to health determinants. Services include access to healthy food, safe housing, and sanctuary. The services need not be provided by healthcare providers. Authorize the Medicaid program to reimburse the types of services described above, if federal funding approval is obtained. Authorize DHS to seek any necessary federal Medicaid state plan amendments or waivers. The language should not restrict the Department in providing the services either through managed care or fee for service. Exempt this new language from the requirements under s.20.940 and s. 49.45(2t).


