Under current law, a person who meets the eligibility requirements for the Wisconsin Works (W-2) program and who is the custodial parent of a child who is 8 weeks old or less may receive monthly grants of \$673 and may not be required to work in a W-2 employment position during that time, unless another adult member of the custodial parent's W-2 group is participating in, or is eligible to participate in, a W-2 employment position or is employed in unsubsidized employment. This bill extends these monthly benefits to the custodial parent of child who is 12 weeks old or less.
