PUBLIC UTILITY REGULATION

The bill makes changes to the broadband expansion program administered by the PSC. Under current law, the PSC makes grants for constructing broadband infrastructure in "underserved" areas, which are defined as areas of the state served by fewer than 2 broadband service providers. The bill revises the definition of "underserved" so that it refers instead to an area of the state in which households or businesses lack access to broadband service of at least 25 megabits per second download speed and 3 megabits per second upload speed. Current law also specifies various criteria for the PSC to prioritize grants for certain types of projects. One of the criteria is to prioritize grants for projects that affect "unserved" areas, which are defined, in part, as areas with internet service that does not exceed minimum speeds based on speeds designated by the Federal Communications Commission. The bill revises the definition of "unserved" so that it refers instead to areas in which households or businesses lack access to broadband service of at least 10 megabits per second download speed and 1 megabit per second upload speed.
