I get a bit lost as to who is drafting what, but you are the drafter for much of my stuff and I think it was you who called me on this yesterday. The proposal, more specifically, is as follows below. Not sure if this changes how it is drafted or not, but thought I should at least pass this along.

Provide up to \$1 million in each year of the biennium to the Wisconsin Disaster Fund for one-time payments to the Town of Washington Island to help offset expenses to repair and replace power infrastructure serving the island residents. Requires a 30% cost share of reasonable and necessary costs incurred and documented by The Washington Island Electric Cooperative utility between June 27, 2018 and April 30, 2019.
