Thanks for the quick turnaround with the MA Expansion.

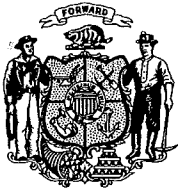
Please change the draft (page 1, line 5) to read: "...each fiscal year from all funding sources to **increase reimbursement rates** for dental services that are covered"

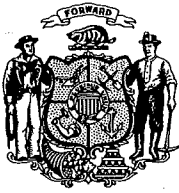
